We are excited to share a major milestone that will take place on Thursday evening regarding the Pennsbury High School Project. The Pennsbury Board of Directors is expected to select an architect to design the new high school.

**Which architect is going to design the new high school?**

At the Board meeting on March 21 @ 7:30 pm, the Board is expected to select one architect to design the new Pennsbury High School. This meeting will be held in person at the Fallsington Elementary School and will also be live-streamed.

**What happens after an architect is selected?**

Once an architect is selected, the design process will take at least one year. Multiple meetings will be held for community members, students, and staff to provide input on the final design.
